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Even India's freedom struggle invested in people like Vinoba Bhave who led Bhutan movement, Baba Amte who sacrificed his entire life for taking care of leprosy patient. That nation making is indeed a task of building leaders of tomorrow.

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further, we see if we scrutinise why planning commission led centralised planning fall short of its goals be it failure of community development programme or sick PSUs. The prime reason was it failed to imbibe the aspirations of masses. Unless people own Responsibility of transforming themselves no country can be developed fully. Hence current focus by NITI Aayog to herald bottom up planning,

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local innovations through local bodies like People's plan & Development as Janandolan is to allow people to build themselves thereby nation.

However, the mute question is do nation realise the real worth of its people? Do they have willpower for building able individuals?

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coucig displayed how our civilisation is fragile. The exodus of migrants from mighty cities showed how we treat our most marginalised people. The stagnant public expenditure in Health with 67% out of pocket expenditure by people, the commercialised profit driven education system and even the issues of nepotism, corruption patriarchy are denying people freedom to build themselves.

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That instead of creating able citizen nations are focussing on narrow identities, wars and xenophobia. The paradox that on one hand 10 million people sleep without meal and at the other  $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of food, is being wasted everyday (FAO) points out to the fact how nations <sup>have</sup> are misguided policies.

The problems of malnutrition among children that 36% children in India are stunted, 20% wasted (NFHS-5) points out that people rather than building nation are focussing on creating empire for themselves that the people in power be it politicians bureaucrats <sup>if</sup> have stale siloed, selfish outlook then chances are that they become liability for nation not asset.

Unless people realise their dreams of all round development their contribution to nation building will suffer.

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and instead of bringing national development they may derail it.

Investing in People - to shape destiny of nation

nation are build brick by brick by its people. The able leaders brings transformational results. for building people capable of building a nation need is to focus on their development by investing in Human capital. Skilling people, giving them freedom to harness their creative spirit, nurturing their talent by merit and Handholding is the basis of strong nation.

Investing in building ethical leaders, emotionally competent youth, digitally empowered masses and community led Governance will go long way.
